

Discount Cinema Card Scheme

The national discount card scheme was set up by the Cinema Exhibitors' Association to help standardise provision of concessionary tickets for carers across the UK. It is a voluntary scheme in which most of the major cinema chains participate.

The CEACARD costs £5.50 and entitles the holder to one free ticket for a person accompanying them to the cinema.

To qualify: you must meet one (or more) of the following criteria.

- a) Be in receipt of Disability Living Allowance
- b) Be a registered blind person

To apply: Application forms are available at all participating cinemas or you can download a form from the website (www.ceacard.co.uk). You will need a passport size photo (with your name on the back), proof of your Disability Living Allowance (photocopy, not an original document) and a cheque/postal order for £5.50.

The application should be sent to: CEACARD, PO Box 199, Deeside, CH5 9BW. It takes approximately 3 weeks to process a claim and issue a CEACARD. It is **valid for 1 year** from the date of issue but cards issued before March 2009 are still valid for 3 years, until their date of expiry.

You can apply for more than one card but you will have to pay the processing fee for each application.

To renew: You will need make a completely new application, a few weeks before your existing card expires.
